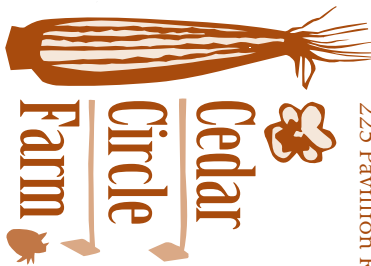

About CSA Membership

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a partnership between community members and farmers who agree to share in the bounty and the risks of farming. CSA members make an investment in the spring when farm costs are high in exchange for a weekly share of the season's harvest at a reduced price. It's like a subscription to fresh food!

We believe that personal contact with the people who grow your food and the land on which it is grown is important—especially with the recent e-coli and salmonella poisonings associated with huge industrial farms across the country. Throughout the growing season CSA members come to the farm to pick up a share of what's in season. CSA shares generally provide 2-3 adults with fresh fruits and vegetables for a week. Members save 18-20% off retail farmstand or market prices with a CSA share and 10% with a CSA Farmstand Dollars Account. In all of its evolving forms, CSA is an optimal way to support and experience local farms. It provides your family with healthy, fresh organic produce and the opportunity to know where their food comes from.

Summer CSA Share \$500/Early Bird \$485

20 weeks (May 29–Oct. 9)
First pick-up May 29

Throughout the growing season we provide you with a weekly list of certified organic crops that are available for your share. On your pre-arranged pick-up day, you come to the farm with your bag or basket and use the CSA share item list to select freshly harvested produce from the farmstand displays. This self-service CSA includes plenty of choices and some pick-your-own crops such as berries, flowers and pumpkins.

Pre-Packed Summer CSA Share – \$575

In a hurry? No problem. Let us pack your basket for you! The cost is an additional \$3.75/week or \$75 for the season. Pre-packed baskets are available between 1-6 PM on your pick-up day.

NEW! Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center (DHMC) Summer CSA Share \$600/Early Bird \$585

20 weeks (May 29 – Oct. 9) First delivery June 1
Friday Pick-up at DHMC between 3:00-5:30 PM

For the convenience of DHMC employees and volunteers, Pre-Packed Summer CSA Shares will be delivered to the hospital on Fridays. Pick up between 3:00-5:30 will be on the sidewalk between the East Mall Norris Cotton Cancer Center entrance and Lot 20.

Fall CSA Share – \$195

5 Saturday pick-ups: Oct. 20-Dec.15
Oct. 20, Nov. 3 & 17, and Dec. 1 & 15

Extend your season and eat more locally grown, organic foods through the holidays with our Fall CSA Share. It provides enough seasonal, storage and cold-hardy crops to take 2-3 adults through December—with a bit extra to store into the winter. Every other Saturday members come to the farm to select storage crops from the item list provided. Other items will be available for sale on these special Farmstand Saturdays. Due to storage limitations there are a **limited number of Fall Shares available. Sign up early!**

Bouquet CSA Share – \$100

8 weeks (July 16–Sept. 3)
\$120 value!

Come to the farm once a week at your convenience and cut twenty flowers of your choice from our spectacular cut-flower garden. Our Bouquet Share is a beautiful way to support the farm using the traditional CSA model, and is a great companion to our other CSA options. This option is perfect for people who might not have time or space to garden but love to have fresh flowers around all the time. Give the gift of flowers to your family, friend or neighbor – popular for Valentine's Day and Mother's Day!

CSA Farmstand Dollars Account Two sizes: \$450 or \$225

Our CSA Farmstand Dollars Account allows you to shop, any day, all season at your convenience. This debit card option represents a 10% discount at the farmstand and greenhouses. This year it can also be used for farm classes and events such as Dinners in the Field. An investment of \$450 buys a \$500 debit card, or \$225 buys a \$250 debit card — while supporting Cedar Circle Farm in the same manner as our Summer or Fall CSA Shares. Replenishment Dollars, in increments of \$250, can be purchased at any time throughout the season.

Must Sign Up by March 1 for Discounts, New Package Deals & Payment Plan Option
Early Birds are very helpful to the farm. To show you just how much we appreciate early payment, those who sign up for CSA Summer Shares before March 1 receive a discount. Also new this year, buy more than one type of CSA Share by March 1 and receive an additional discount. Payments can be divided into three installments at no extra charge when you sign up on or before March 1. (See payment plan details on registration form on the back.)

Summer & Fall CSA Share Package

Early Bird \$675 – a \$20 savings
Get fresh, organic veggies May-December. Includes a 10% CSA member discount on all farmstand purchases, classes and events.

Full Season Package! Summer, Fall & Bouquet CSA Share

Early Bird \$770 – a \$25 savings
Get fresh, organic veggies from May through December, plus 8 weeks of summer flower bouquets, and a 10% CSA member discount on all farmstand purchases, classes and events.

CSA members also receive **10% off all farmstand purchases plus classes and events.** Throughout the season you receive e-newsletters with weekly share item lists, tips on how to use the veggies in your share, updates on farm events, and news from the field. *Be sure to sign up for our e-news on your CSA registration form.*

Subsidized Shares for Limited-Income Vermonters

Cedar Circle Farm has participated in the Northeast Organic Farming Association of Vermont's Farmshare Program for the past four years. CSA shares are available to limited-income Vermonters from participating farms at half the cost. Eligible Vermonters pay 50%, and the farm and NOFA each pay 25%. For eligibility contact the NOFA-VT office at 802-434-4122 or download a Farmshare Program application form at CedarCircleFarm.org/csa.

Summer Share Pick-Up Day Details

Weekly shares can be picked up at the farm on your pre-selected pick-up day of Tuesday-Friday between 11 AM-6 PM. Pre-packed CSA Shares are ready after 1 PM. There is a limited number of pick-ups per day. **Pick-up days are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, so sign up early in order to get the day you want!**

Split Shares

We welcome you to split a share with friends or neighbors and recommend that you alternate pick-up weeks rather than try to split the contents of each week's share.
